Perusing the new music will help you improve your sight-reading, finger dexterity, scale/key recognition, exposure to new styles, range development, and better musicianship and technique. WHAT ARE YOU WAITING FOR?
- 5. First, download a scale warm-up. Start with something easy and that you have done before (GM for violins or BbM for winds.) Then, explore several keys with which you are unfamiliar.
