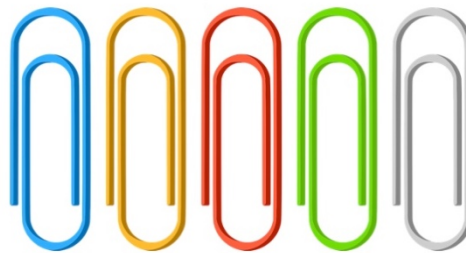

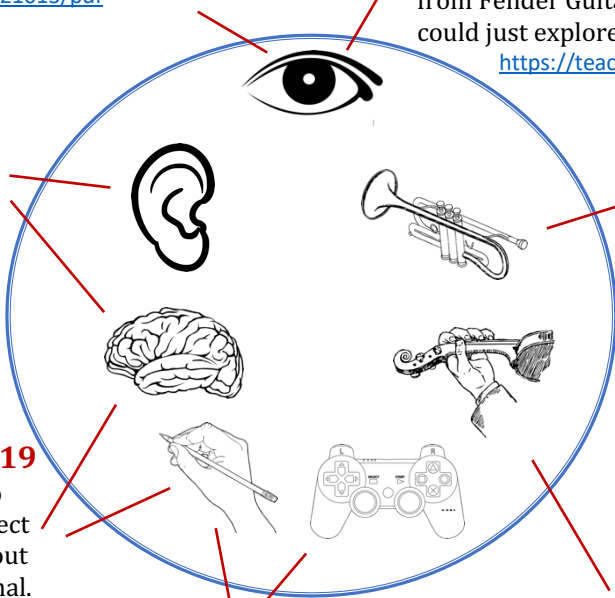
Not to leave the violins, violas, or cellos with practice resources, Mrs. Fox is sharing a few of her favorite links. Take the time to peruse and play with these!
